Western Disposal offers contractors, builders and homeowners construction waste recycling services to assist in meeting your recycling goals.

Our Materials Management Center is home to Boulder County’s only semi-automated construction waste materials sorting center. Funded in part by a grant from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, this service supports customers in attaining their waste diversion goals while protecting the environment, conserving resources and creating jobs.

Recoverable Material Accepted for Sorting & Recycling



Aggregates

Clean concrete, asphalt, brick, cinderblock, pavers and porcelain.



Metal

Ductwork, rebar, non-cfc appliances, other ferrous and non-ferrous metals



Wood

Unpainted/unstained/untreated dimensional lumber



Fiber

Cardboard



If an item or material is not listed above, it cannot be recycled at our facility. To successfully be sorted & recycled, material cannot be co-joined to a different and/or non-recyclable material. For example: drywall to studs, plumbing to porcelain, rebar to concrete.

Construction Waste Diversion Reporting



Western Disposal will track your container weights and recycling percentages for construction waste sort and source-separated recyclable material containers.

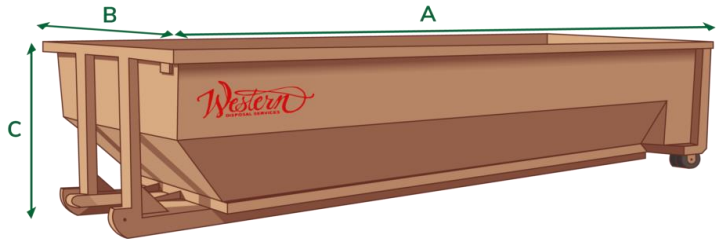
Reporting is done by project and is based on actual weights, not historical averages. This allows you to track your recycling success by the job, providing insight for potential improvements.

Containers Available

Choose from source-separate containers for each material (you sort the materials at your job site) or a mixed box, where all recyclable material can be combined, and Western will sort it for an additional fee. Please note only de minimis amounts of non-recyclable materials are allowed in mixed boxes.

Hazardous Materials Strictly Forbidden



The **WASTE DEFINED** clause in your roll-off contract with Western Disposal prohibits hazardous or toxic wastes as defined by local, state or federal laws or regulations. These wastes include but are not limited to: asbestos-containing material, contaminated soil, wood with lead-based paint, oil-based paints or solvents, florescent lamps, mercury-containing devices.
