Western Disposal offers contractors, builders, and homeowners construction waste recycling services to assist in meeting your recycling goals and requirements.

Our Materials Management Center is home to Boulder County's only semi-automated construction waste materials sorting center. Funded in part by a grant from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, this service supports customers in attaining their waste diversion goals while protecting the environment, conserving resources, and creating jobs.

Recoverable Material Accepted for Sorting & Recycling



Aggregates

Clean concrete, asphalt, brick, cinderblock, pavers, and porcelain



Metal

Ductwork, rebar, non-cfc appliances, other ferrous and non-ferrous metals



Wood

Unpainted/unstained/untreated dimensional lumber



Fiber Cardboard

Western Disposal accepts material generated from new construction projects and deconstruction projects only. Material co-joined with a different and/or non-recyclable material cannot be sorted and will be landfilled.

Demolished debris is not accepted for sorting.

Construction Waste Diversion Reporting



Twelve to thirty-yard construction waste recycling containers are sorted individually. Reporting is based on actual weights and material content. This allows you to track the recycling success of each haul, providing insight into potential improvements.

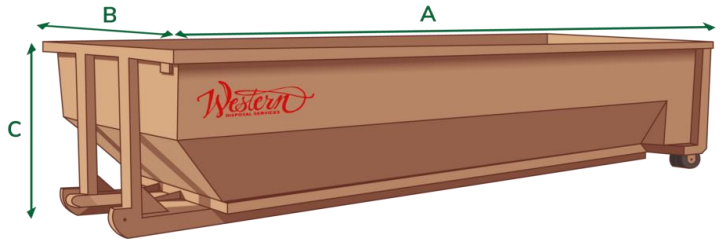

Containers Available

Choose from source-separate containers for each material (you sort the materials at your job site) or a mixed box, where all recyclable material can be combined, and Western will sort it for an additional fee. Please note only de minimis amounts of non-recyclable materials are allowed in mixed boxes.

Hazardous Materials Strictly Forbidden



The **WASTE DEFINED** clause in your roll-off contract with Western Disposal prohibits hazardous or toxic wastes as defined by local, state or federal laws or regulations. These wastes include but are not limited to: asbestos-containing material, contaminated soil, wood with lead-based paint, oil-based paints or solvents, florescent lamps, mercury-containing devices.
