

Construction Waste Recycling Hazardous Waste Form

OVERVIEW

Western Disposal's Materials Management Center is home to Boulder County's only semi-automated construction waste materials sorting center. Western requires that users of our construction waste sorting services affirm that their loads do not contain any material that is categorized as hazardous as defined by local, state or federal laws or regulations.

Recoverable Material Accepted for Sorting & Recycling

Western Disposal accepts material generated from new construction projects and deconstruction projects only.

Material generated from demolition projects is not accepted for recycling but can be tipped at our facility as trash.



Aggregates: Concrete, asphalt, brick, cinderblock, pavers, and porcelain
Metal: Ductwork, rebar, non-CFC appliances, water heaters, other ferrous and non-ferrous metals
Wood: Pallets and unpainted/unstained/untreated dimensional lumber
Fiber: Cardboard



If an item or material is not listed above, it cannot be recycled at our facility. To successfully be sorted & recycled, the material cannot be co-joined with a different and/or non-recyclable material. For example, drywall to studs or plumbing to porcelain.

Hazardous Materials Strictly Prohibited

Customers are required to affirm below that their load does not contain hazardous materials, including but not limited to asbestos-containing material, contaminated soil, wood with lead-based paint, oil-based paints or solvents, fluorescent lamps, and mercury-containing devices.

I affirm that the waste being delivered to Western Disposal Inc. does not contain hazardous or toxic waste as defined by local, state or federal laws or regulations. Any expense or liability incurred because of illegal dumping of hazardous material will be the responsibility of the undersigned:
